Getting to know your telephone



Display gives information on current call

Programmable keys and LEDs

These keys are either line keys, with corresponding LEDs, or function keys.

Light

Light indicates messages received

Disconnect Key

Terminating a call or programming.

Guide Key

To check or modify your programming

Audio Key

Loudspeaker





Reduce Volume

Increase Volume

Making / Receiving Calls

To make an internal call Press the relevant **Extension Key** or dial the

Extension Number

To make an External call Dial **9** then the **Telephone Number**

To answer a call Lift the handset

Transferring / Holding Calls

To hold a call Press 2 or the **Hold** key

To retrieve a held call Press the Int/Ext key with the **Red**

flashing Light

To transfer a call Call the Ext Number and then press transfer

To cancel transfer Press Press then the INT/Ext key with the Red

flashing Light

To transfer to external While on the 1st call dial the 2nd telephone

number or extension number, this will put the 1st call on hold. Transfer or retrieve the

1st call as normal.

Speed Dials

To dial by name Press **DIRECT** then letters of the name you require

Press or to scroll

Press end to send

To dial by Speed Dial Dial the Speed Dial Number (please see your list)

System Features

To use Touch Tones Dial **69** before you choose your options

To activate Call Back Dial the Extension Number and press #

To cancel Call Back Press #

Redial Dial 40

To have a Conference Call During your call dial the person you wish

to include and when they answer dial 50

Group pick-up Dial 14

Individual call pick-up Dial 13 and the relevant Extension Number

To park a call Dial 12

(Store a call on an extension)

To retrieve a parked call Dial 12 then the Extension Number that the call is

parked on

Diverts

To Divert Internal/External Calls

divert to

Dial 61 and the Extension Number you wish to

To Divert on Busy Dial 62 and the Extension Number you wish to

divert to

To set a DND (Do Not Disturb) Dial 63

To cancel all Diversions Dial 60

Text Messaging

Receiving a text message/

Unanswered Call

Press Mail

Press 2. The callers will be revealed.

Press to call back
Long Press to delete

To clear a Text Message Press Mail

Press 2

Long Press <a> to delete

To send a Text Message Press Mail

Press 2

Dial the destination **Extension**

Number

Press to scroll

Press to send the message

Personal Speed Dials

Note that a **Speed** key will need to be configured by G B Telecom

To program Personal Speed Dial Press **Speed**

Press 🕮

Dial number from 0 - 9

Insert the name using the keypad

Press

Insert the external telephone number (prefixed by a

9)

Press

To call a Personal Speed Dial Press **Speed**

Press number from 0 – 9 or and to scroll

Press to call

To delete Personal Speed Dial Press **Speed**

Press 🕮

Dial number 0 - 9 to be deleted

Long Press <a>key to delete name

Press to confirm

Long Press <a> key to delete number

Press to confirm

Changing Ring Tones / Contrast

Change your Ring tone/Volume

Press 🕮

Press 5

Press 3

Wait for guide to finish

Press 1 repeatedly for choice of ring tone or Press 2 repeatedly for choice of volume

Press # to select

To change screen Contrast

Press 🕮

Press 5

Press 3

Press 2

Press 1

Press # to select

Voicemail

To initialise your mailbox Press **Mail**

It will ask you to enter a 4 digit personal password

(default 2222)
Press # to confirm
Say your name

Press #

To record your message Press Mail

Press 3

Enter your 4 digit personal password

Press 4 for Personal Options Press 1 to Change Greeting Press 4 to Record Greeting

Press # to Confirm

Accessing your message Press Mail

Press 3

Enter your password – 2222 (default password)

Press 1 to Listen to your message

Press 2 to Archive

Press 3 to erase your message

Accessing your message from

Out with the office

Dial your DDI number

When your message begins press * then #

on your telephone

Enter your mailbox number
Enter your personal password
Press 1 to listen to your message
Press 2 to archive the message

Press 3 to erase

To Activate your Voicemail Dial 61 and then 51

To take your Voicemail off Dial 60

Note: If you have a voicemail box, your calls will automatically go to voicemail after 6 rings.
